## VILLAGE MISSIONS PRAYER SPOTLIGHT

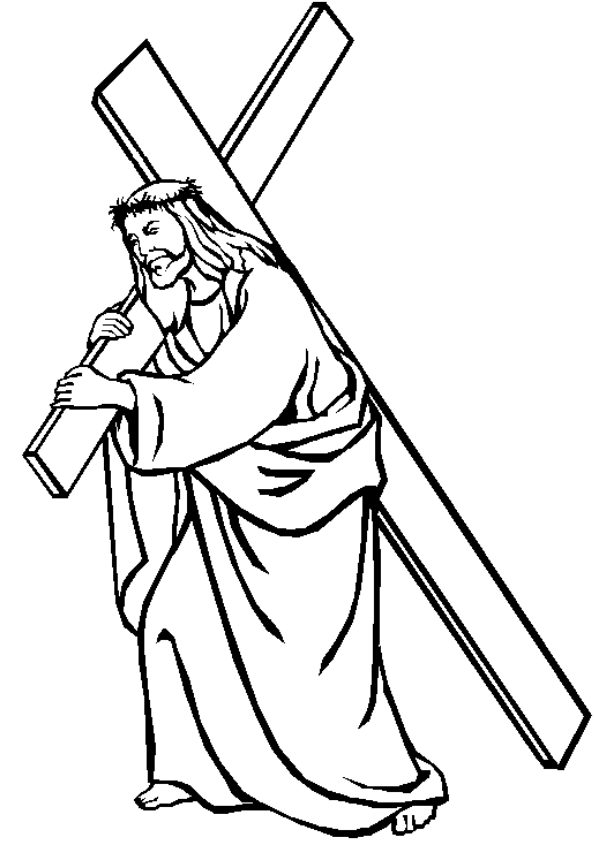

We're in the foothills near Jackson, CA. When we first came here, this was a retirement and recreational community; then there was a large housing boom and many people moved into the area. With the current economic downturn, many of those have now moved away. Pray for God to bring healing to our family, renew our strength, and use us as His instruments to reach the people of Camanche with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Pray that we continue caring for Camanche through Christ. Pray for a solution to the church's logistical challenges. We have no building of our own, and the landlord lost the building we were using. The building reverted back to a previous owner, who asked us to leave, so it has sat empty for over a year. Meanwhile we've been allowed to meet in the community center, but it is logistically challenging to say the least. We're glad to have a place to meet, but we only have two rooms. We use one as a sanctuary that seats 40-50 comfortably, and a smaller room for all the children. We need more room, if we're going to be able to meet the needs of our community.

## **Divine Reasoning's of Faith**

*"But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you."*

Matthew 6:33

Immediately we look at these words of Jesus, we find them the most revolutionary statement human ears ever listened to. "Seek ye first the kingdom of God." We argue in exactly the opposite way-"But I must live; I must make so much money; I must be clothed; I must be fed." The great concern of our lives is not the kingdom of God, but how we are to fit ourselves to live. Jesus reverses the order: Get rightly related to God first, maintain that as the great care of your life, and never put the concern of your care on the other things.

"Take no thought for your life .... " Our Lord points out the utter unreasonableness from His standpoint of being so anxious over the means of living. Jesus is not saying that the man who takes thought for nothing is blessed-that man is a fool. Jesus taught that a disciple has to make his relationship to God the dominating concentration of his life, and to be carefully careless about everything else in comparison to that. Jesus is saying-"Don't make the ruling factor of your life what you shall eat and what you shall drink, but be concentrated absolutely on God." Some people are careless over what they eat and drink, and they suffer for it; they are careless about what they wear, and they look as they have no business to look; they are careless about their earthly affairs, and God holds them responsible. Jesus is saying that the great care of the life is to put the relationship to God first, and everything else second.

It is one of the severest disciplines of the Christian life to allow the Holy Spirit to bring us into harmony with the teaching of Jesus in these verses.
